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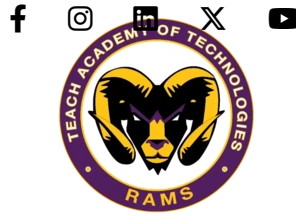

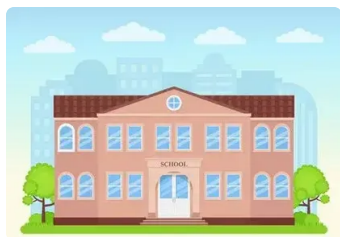

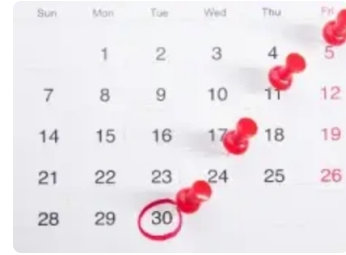

The Reading Corner



15-Minute Family Writing Routine

Talk First, Write Second

Objective: Help children build confidence, fluency, and clear thinking through short, daily writing at home. This routine is simple, low pressure, and designed to feel natural for families.

The 15-Minute Routine

Minutes 1–3: Talk It Out

Have a short conversation before writing.

Ask questions like:

- What was the best part of your day?
- What made you laugh today?
- What was something hard?
- What did you learn?

Talking first helps children organize their ideas before they write.

Minutes 4–10: Quick Write

Set a timer for 6 minutes. Students write without stopping.

Rules:

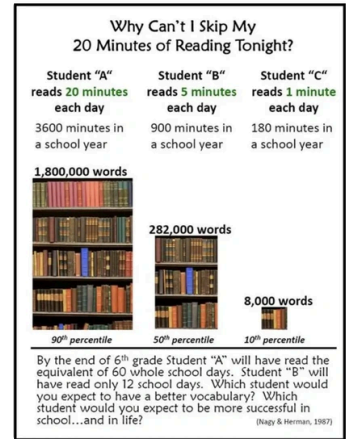
- Do not worry about spelling
- Do not erase
- Keep writing the whole time

Prompt ideas:

- Today I felt proud because...
- Something interesting I noticed...
- If I could change one thing about today...
- A small problem I solved...

Minutes 11–13: Share

- Children read their writing aloud.
- Say things like: Tell me more, I like how you described that, or what happened next?
- Avoid correcting every mistake. Focus on ideas and effort.

About TAT Counseling Program

The counseling program at TEACH Academy of Technologies provides various services for all students and is designed to assist students in developing socially, emotionally, and academically. We provide counseling support through individual and small groups, classroom lessons, school events, and collaboration with staff and parents.

The role of a school counselor is to provide short-term interventions, that help students with concerns impacting their school performance. **School counselors do not diagnose or provide therapy.** If further support is needed, we collaborate with families to discuss options for ongoing outside support.

Acerca Del Programa Consejero De TAT

El programa de consejería de TEACH Academy of Technologies brinda diversos servicios para todos los estudiantes y está diseñado para ayudarlos a desarrollarse social, emocional y académicamente. Proporcionamos apoyo consejero individual o en grupo, lecciones en la clase, eventos escolares y colaboración con el personal y los padres.

La función de un consejero escolar es proporcionar intervenciones a corto plazo que ayuden a los estudiantes con inquietudes que afectan su desempeño escolar. **Los consejeros escolares no diagnostican ni proporcionan terapia.** Si se necesita más apoyo, colaboramos con las familias para discutir opciones de apoyo externo.



Purposeful Group Structures

Objective: Teachers will implement one structured group routine that increases participation, academic talk, and accountability.

Why This Matters (2 Minutes)

Students often struggle with group work because expectations and roles are unclear. Clear structure creates safety, accountability, and stronger learning outcomes.

The Strategy: Structured 4 Protocol (10 Minutes)

Step 1: Assign Roles (2 Minutes)

Groups of 4 students. Each student has a defined responsibility:

- Facilitator – Keeps the group focused and ensures everyone speaks
- Recorder – Writes the group’s final answer
- Evidence Finder – Locates proof from text, notes, or data
- Reporter – Shares the group’s thinking with the class

Step 2: Clear Task with Accountability (1 Minute)

Provide a specific product instead of open-ended discussion. Example: Identify ONE claim and TWO pieces of evidence. The Recorder submits the final answer.

Step 3: Timed Discussion (4 Minutes)

- 1 minute silent thinking time
- 3 minutes structured discussion

The teacher circulates and listens for academic talk, equal participation, and evidence use.

Step 4: Random Reporter Share-Out (3 Minutes)


Randomly select a group’s Reporter to present. This ensures every student prepares and participates.

When To Use It

- After direct instruction
- Before independent practice
- During text analysis
- During math problem solving
- During review or assessment prep

Accountability

- Have students complete a quick reflection or exit ticket: What contribution did you make to your group today? How did it support the success of your group work?

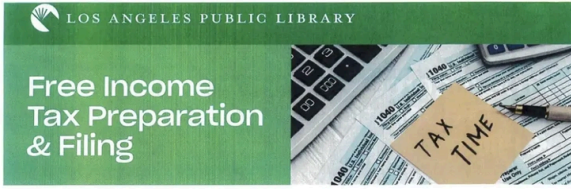

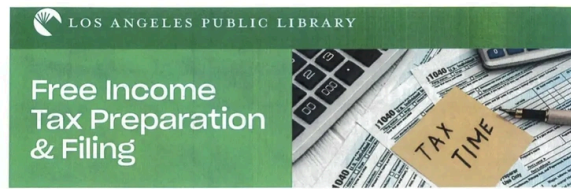
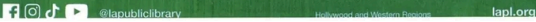
