1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

The school did not use grant funds for SY 23-24 but planned for the implementation of arts programming in SY 24-25.

The grant will be used to fund 33% of the salary for an IT position. This individual will rotate through classrooms throughout the year, teaching units of coding and graphic design. The curriculum will give students hands-on experience in two key areas of technology—programming and digital design—preparing them for future academic and career opportunities in the fast-growing fields of technology and creative industries. An Aide will also support the IT position in delivering these lessons, and the grant will fund 33% of this Aide's salary as well.

By supporting technological skill development through coding and graphic design, the grant provides a well-rounded educational experience. It encourages students to explore diverse interests and build skills that will benefit them in both creative and technical disciplines.
