

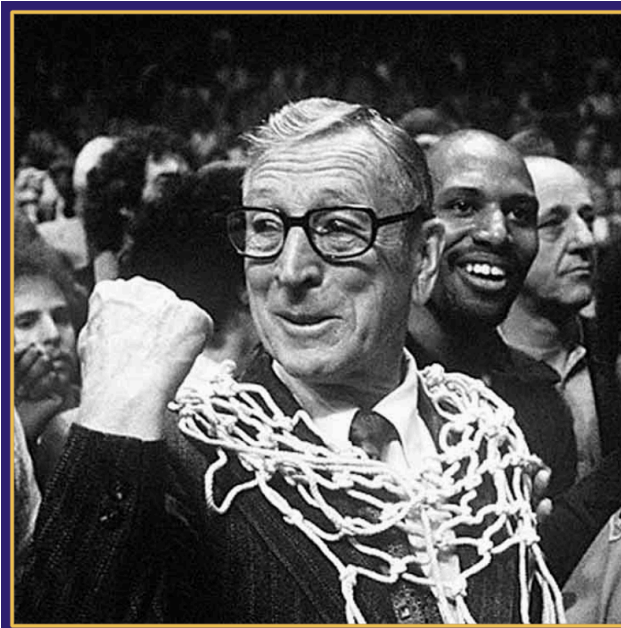

Entry Protocol

Line students up at the door	Welcome each student one at a time while holding your seating chart	Make sure students are in uniform	Let students know that the Do Now is on the board/desk
Set the noise expectation → Silent	Remind and then watch each student put their phone in the box	Take attendance	

Exit Protocol

After the last minute tell students to pack up	Set the noise expectation → Silent	Move to the hallway side of the door	Watch each student remove their own phone in the box as they exit

A. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT/CLASS RIGOR / *DESARROLLO PROFESIONAL / RIGOR DE CLASE*

Mr. Menduke shared various slides that are part of recent professional development specific to expectations for the rest of the academic school year. Mr. Menduke particularly shared the classroom rigor that is currently discussed and seen at TEACH. Mr. Menduke shared that he has been observing classrooms and coaching teachers. Mr. Menduke shared that a focus on school culture will be reemphasized moving forward this current school year. / *El Sr. Menduke compartió varias diapositivas que forman parte del desarrollo profesional reciente específico de las expectativas para el resto del año escolar académico. El Sr. Menduke compartió particularmente el rigor en el aula que actualmente se discute y se ve en TEACH. El Sr. Menduke compartió que ha estado observando las aulas y entrenando a los maestros. El Sr. Menduke compartió que en el año escolar en curso se volverá a enfatizar el enfoque en la cultura escolar.*

B. CAMPUS PROTOCOLS / PROTOCOLOS DE LA ESCUELA

Mr. Menduke shared that they have reimplemented campus entry and exit protocols for students which has been helpful for all students. This has been particularly important now since the hallways were becoming more chaotic. Mr. Menduke shared that the campus simply feels safer due to these protocols. / *El Sr. Menduke compartió que han reimplementado los protocolos de entrada y salida de la escuela para los estudiantes lo cual ha sido útil para todos los estudiantes. Esto ha sido particularmente importante ahora que los pasillos se estaban volviendo más caóticos. Menduke compartió que el campus simplemente se siente más seguro gracias a estos protocolos.*

C. COLLEGE ACCEPTANCES / ACEPTACIONES UNIVERSITARIAS

Mr. Menduke reiterated the importance of the lobby monitor which has pictures and information of our students who have been accepted to colleges and universities thus far. Mr. Menduke shared that the CSU campuses have been announcing college acceptances while the UC campuses will begin shortly. Importantly, all 12th grade students applied to 4 schools and at least 2 scholarships. / *El Sr. Menduke reiteró la importancia del monitor del vestíbulo que tiene fotografías e información de nuestros estudiantes que han sido aceptados en colegios y universidades hasta el momento. El Sr. Menduke compartió que las universidades del CSUs han anunciado sus aceptaciones, mientras que las universidades de UC comenzarán en breve. Es importante destacar que todos los estudiantes de 12° grado solicitaron ingreso a 4 escuelas y al menos 2 becas.*

D. SCHOOL DAYS REMAINING

Mr. Menduke shared that there are 66 school days left. Summer planning will commence shortly. / *El Sr. Menduke compartió que quedan 66 días escolares. La planificación del verano comenzará en breve.*

E. WASC

Mr. Menduke shared an update of our WASC review, which is the accreditation for the State of California. He shared that we received a 6 year renewal which is the maximum amount of years we

can receive. Mr. Menduke thanked those parents who participated in the parent share portion of their visit. / *El Sr. Menduke compartió información de nuestra revisión WASC, que es la acreditación del estado de California. Compartió que recibimos una renovación de 6 años, que es la cantidad máxima de años que podemos recibir. El Sr. Menduke agradeció a los padres que participaron en la parte de su visita para compartir con los padres.*
